JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Respond to emergency calls including structure fires, wildland fires, vehicle accidents, technical rescues, hazardous materials incidents, and emergency medical calls.
- Participate in fire suppression, extrication, and scene mitigation operations.
- Attend and actively participate in two monthly training drills (typically 6:00 PM – 10:00 PM on the 2nd & 4th Tuesdays).
- Assist with fire prevention, public education, and community outreach.
- Maintain apparatus, equipment, and station readiness.
- Complete required training courses and certifications.
- Perform special assignments as approved by the Fire Chief.

JOB SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS

Minimum Qualifications:

- At least 18 years of age
- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid Montana Driver's License
- Must live within a reasonable response time to the fire station
- Ability to pass a comprehensive background check
- Physically capable of passing the department's Physical Agility Test

Preferred / Required Training (provided by the department):

- 92-hour Basic Firefighting Course (within first year)
- 16-hour Wildland Firefighting Course (within first year)
- First Aid, CPR, and preferably EMT certification
- Willingness to attend additional training opportunities

Key Skills & Attributes:

Strong candidates should demonstrate strong teamwork and communication skills, the ability to perform effectively under pressure in emergency situations, excellent physical fitness and mental resilience, reliability and punctuality with a strong commitment to monthly drills (no more than 6 absences per year), and a genuine dedication to public service and continuous learning.
