
New Snow Route Information

Certain streets have been designated as Tier I or Tier II Snow Routes and will have limited parking from November 1 through May 1 in order to clear and maintain the city streets and to allow for safe vehicular traffic and parking.

Tier 1 Routes

Tier I Snow Routes are critical driving routes and must be kept clear for emergency services and critical access. In the event that the City Manager declares a Snow Event no vehicles, trailers, or equipment should be parked on streets designated as Tier I Snow Routes until the City Manager declares the Snow Event has ended.

A Snow Event

The City Manager may declare a "Snow Event" if the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration ("NOAA") forecasts snow accumulation equal to or greater than four (4) inches or if there is actual accumulation of snow equal to or greater than four (4) inches for any 24-hour period from twelve o'clock (12:00) P.M. (noon) until twelve o'clock (12:00) P.M. (noon). A declared Snow Event shall continue in effect until such time that the City Manager declares the Snow Event to be ended. Parking restrictions will go into effect 8 hours after a declared snow event.

How will I know

Each fall the City of Lewistown will publish a notice in the paper, discuss on the radio and post flyers around the community, informing the public of the parking restrictions.

When it has been determined that the minimum accumulation of four (4) inches of snow has been exceeded and/or a Snow Event is declared, the City Manager or a designee will notify the public by an appropriate method that an emergency exists and when the event has ended. This information will be posted on the City of Lewistown's website (www.cityoflewistown.com) and on our Facebook page (Citylewistownmt). We will also share this information with the radio and the Fergus County Disaster and Emergency Services.

Tier 1 Streets

No parking during Snow Event or actual accumulation of four (4) inches of snow.

Frequently Asked Questions

- What if it snows more than 4 inches overnight?

You should move your vehicle as soon as possible plows will be out as soon as possible.

- What if it snows while I am out of town?

Between November 1st and May 1st you should park off the snow route, or have someone that can move your vehicle if there is a declared snow event.

- Where do I park?

You should park your vehicle or trailer on a side street, in a driveway, or on your property.

Penalties

Any vehicle, motor vehicle, trailer or equipment parked in violation of this section may be ticketed and/or towed. The registered owner of such vehicle, trailer, or equipment shall, in addition to any fine may be responsible for all towing and storage expenses.

Every person convicted of a violation of this section shall be punished by a fine of \$25.00. For a second conviction within one (1) year after the first conviction, the person shall be punished by a fine of \$50.00. Upon a third or subsequent conviction within one (1) year after the first conviction, the person shall be punished by a fine of \$100.00.
