Class Title: Street Worker I or II

Accountable to: Public Works Director

Wages and Benefits: the wage for the Street Worker I position is \$18.50 per hour and Street Worker II is \$20.97 per hour. It is a full time position. Health insurance is provided by the City of Lewistown. A probationary period of six months will be required.

Primary Objective of Position: under close supervision, performs a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled manual labor tasks in the construction and maintenance of streets, sewers, water lines, parks, cemetery, buildings and other facilities; occasionally drives truck and operates light equipment; work varies somewhat, subject to close supervision.

Essential Job Functions: work is primarily that of a laborer and duties may involve physical work requiring walking, crawling, climbing, and lifting up to 50#s (greater with assistance); work may be performed in undesirable physical conditions of noise, pollution heat, cold, and dampness; may be exposed to hazards and infectious wastes; must be able to follow oral and written instructions; must possess an appropriate Montana's Operator's license.

Major Areas of Accountability and Performance: may operate various types of light equipment, including mowers, trimmers and single axle trucks; performs annual labor in the cemetery, maintenance, repair and minor construction of streets, alleys water and sewer lines, parks sprinkler systems. Street signs, building maintenance, and related facilities; may perform janitorial task; check tires, oil lubricant, water and fuel of assigned equipment; maintain grounds in park around public buildings and cemetery as assigned; may assist in traffic control at work sites; and performs other duties as assigned.

Prepares records of work activities; contact with others is incidental to performance of duties and requires common courtesy and relaying information; work performed often requires care and use of proper safety equipment and procedures to prevent injury.

Supervision – Responsibility for work of others: None.

Education, Training and Experience Requirements: Graduation from high school or equivalent and some work experience. Possession of appropriate Montana Operator's license. Must be able to obtain a Class B CDL

Examples of Performance Criteria and Expectations: Performs semi-skilled and unskilled manual labor in the maintenance of facilities; operates light equipment such as mowers, trimmers and light trucks in a safe manner;

Follows oral and written instructions; performs such duties as may be assigned.
